- City Hall grounds will be open for teams to set up and/or cook onsite at 10am the day of
- CASA will sell soft drinks, water and beer onsite
- The Dave Mayley Band will play from 4-7pm
- Prizes to be awarded at 6:30pm
- Prize categories include 1st, 2nd and 3rd place for Best Red Beans, Best Cornbread, Best Non-traditional Red Bean Dish, Best Decorated Booth and People's Choice
