CASA Donors are now eligible to apply for MS Charity tax credits!

Are you filing as individual or business?
This determines your credit limits.

Business Owner

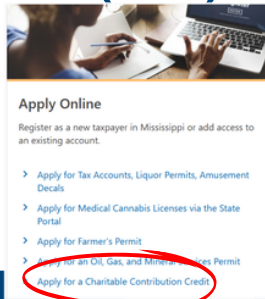
ECO credit:
Up to 50% of state income tax liability
Ad Valorem Tax
(50% of real property tax liability)

Individuals

QFCCO Credit:
Single: up to \$1,500
Married: up to \$3,000
Ad Valorem Tax
(50% of real property tax liability)

Apply Online

- Visit tap.dor.ms.gov & click "Apply for a Charitable Contribution Credit"
- Select **ECO** Credit & Year
- Complete tax information & submit
- Select "Court Appointed Special Advocates of South Mississippi" as charitable organization



- Visit tap.dor.ms.gov & click "Apply for a Charitable Contribution Credit"
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- Complete tax information & submit
- Select "Court Appointed Special Advocates of South Mississippi" as charitable organization

Within 30 days, the Department of Revenue sends a letter of approval with confirmation number & letter ID number.

Donate

Within 60 days after letter is received, you should make a donation to Court Appointed Special Advocates of South Mississippi (dba CASA of South Mississippi) by sending a check to **644 Dunbar Avenue, Bay St. Louis, MS 39520** or donating online at **casasouthms.org/donate**



Proof of Donation

CASA sends a tax receipt letter to donor to upload to MS DOR's website within 7 days.

Donor will receive **final approval letter** by mail from DOR.

*If donor has applied tax credit to property tax, the **final approval letter** & **tax receipt** should be presented to the County Tax Collector, who will complete their portion & submit to DOR for reimbursement to the county.
Donor retains final approval letter & tax receipt.
